ARALIA (SPIKENARD)

Location: Zone 3, best in part sun, moist soil

Shape: Mounded, large clump

Foliage: Large, bright gold, tropical looking, deer resistant

Flowers: Small white, August-September

Notes: Tropical looking, compound leaves are the highlight of this plant. Late summer brings tiny white flowers that are followed by dark purple, inedible berries. Shade tolerant and deer resistant.

Sun King Aralia cordata 'Sun King'

36-48" x 36-48" Part shade Zone 3

Large, bright gold, tropical looking foliage forms large, mounded clumps. Small white flowers bloom in August and September. Prefers moist soil. Deer resistant.
