

DICENTRA (BLEEDING HEART)

Location: Zone 3, part sun to shade

Shape: Arching stems, mounded

Foliage: Green to gray-green

Flowers: Spring to Summer

Notes: The pillow-like flower is heart shaped with a single dangling pendulous drop. Foliage is delicate and finely cut. Some varieties may go dormant by mid-summer if planted in too much sun or heat.

Gold Heart *Dicentra spectabilis* 'Gold Heart'
18-24" x 24-36" Part sun/shade Zone 3

Mounded foliage is golden yellow in part shade and chartreuse in deep shade. Arching sprays of pink and white heart-shaped blooms appear in spring.

King of Hearts *Dicentra* 'King of Hearts'
10" x 12" Part sun/shade Zone 3

Pink, heart-shaped flowers bloom from June through September. Finely-divided, fern-like, gray-green compound leaves. Prefers moist, well-drained soil.



Old Fashioned Pink *Dicentra spectabilis*
36" x 36" Part sun/shade Zone 3

Arching stems form a mound of deeply cut, green foliage with rose-pink heart-shaped flowers from April to June. Often goes dormant in summer heat.



Old Fashioned White *Dicentra spectabilis* 'Alba'
24-36" x 24-36" Part sun/shade Zone 3

Arching stems form a mound of deeply cut, green foliage with white heart-shaped flowers from April to June. Often goes dormant in summer heat.



Valentine® *Dicentra spectabilis* 'Hordival' PP 22,739
24-30" x 24-30" Part sun/shade Zone 3

These puffy, heart-shaped flowers are red with a single dangling, pendulous white drop that bloom in May on red, arching stems. Foliage is dark green with a hint of red.
