GERANIUM (CRANESBILL)

Zone 3-4, sun to part shade, well-drained soil Location:

Shape: Mounded

Foliage: Medium to dark green

Flowers: Summer

Notes: Some varieties have red tinged fall foliage. Good border and edging plants. With the more vigorous of plants, after blooming, a light shearing will bring on a second flush of bloom later in the fall.

Geranium macrorrhizum Bevan's Variety' **Bevan's Variety** 10-15" x 18-24" Sun/part shade Zone 3

Spreading mound of large fragrant green leaves, bearing deep pink flowers in early summer. Drought and heat tolerant.

Biokovo 12" x 18"

Geranium cantabrigiense Biokovo' Sun/light shade Zone 4

Flowers are white to light pink with red sepals and bloom from June to August. Green foliage is fragrant and heavily lobed and forms a dense mound.

Dark Reiter	Geranium pratense Dark	Reiter'
8-10" x 12"	Sun/part shade	Zone 4

Forms a compact mound of dark purple, finely-cut foliage. Lilac-blue flowers bloom from June to August. Prefers well-drained soil.

Max Frei	Geranium sanguinem	Max Frei'
12-18" x 12"	Sun/part shade	Zone 3

Dense mound of purple-pink flowers bloom from June to August. Dense mound of heavily lobed, dark green foliage turns crimson in fall. Prefers well-drained soil.

Rozanne	Geranium x Rozanne' P	P 12,175
18" x 18-24"	Sun/part shade	Zone 4

From May through October, cup shaped, blue-violet flowers cover the sprawling mound of foliage. Leaves are green with chartreuse marbling. Does best in well-drained soil.
