

# LIATRIS (GAYFEATHER)

**Location:** Zone 3, sun, drought tolerant

**Shape:** Upright

**Foliage:** Narrow, green

**Flowers:** Summer to fall

**Notes:** Liatris, also known as Blazing Star or Gayfeather, thrives in the heat, and sends up tall feathery stalks of bright pink-purple or white flowers from attractive grassy tufts of foliage in mid summer. Attracts butterflies.

**Floristan Violet** *Liatris spicata 'Floristan Violet'*

30-36" x 18" Full sun Zone 3

Long, rosy-purple flower spikes bloom from June through September. Taller than Kobold. Drought and heat tolerant.



**Floristan White** *Liatris spicata 'Floristan White'*

36" x 20-24" Full Sun Zone 3

Tall, feathery, white flower spikes bloom from June to September. Attractive grassy tufts of green foliage grows in an upright clump. Heat and drought tolerant.



**Kobold** *Liatris spicata 'Kobold'*

18-24" x 18" Full Sun Zone 3

Tall feathery stalks of lilac-purple bloom atop attractive grassy green tufts of foliage from July through September. Attracts butterflies and is heat and drought tolerant.
