## **MOLINA (MOOR GRASS)**

**Location:** Zones 4, sun to part shade

**Shape:** Mounded clump

Foliage: Green and gold variegated

Flowers: Summer to fall

**Notes:** The mature plants may produce profuse numbers of erect to slightly arching flowering stems, however, the flowering stems have a certain transparent quality. Prefers acidic soils with consistent moisture and tolerates light shade.

Variegata Molina caerulea var. 'Variegata' 24" x 24" Sun/part shade Zone 4

Mounded clump of green and gold variegated leaves. Slightly arching stems with gold to bronze seed heads from June through September have a transparent quality.
