## NEPETA (CATMINT)

**Location:** Zone 4, sun to part shade

Shape: Mounded

Foliage: Scented, blue-green to gray green

Flowers: Summer to fall

**Notes:** This member of the mint family is extremely easy growing with few pests or problems. The billowing foliage is topped with spikes of flowers in early summer with repeat blooms throughout the season.
