

BAPTISIA (FALSE INDIGO)

Location: Zone 4, sun to part shade, wet to dry soil, Midwest native

Shape: Upright, shrub-like

Foliage: Blue-green, compound

Flowers: Late spring to mid summer

Notes: Baptisia is a member of the pea family and you'll notice a resemblance in its foliage and flowers. Black-brown seed pods appear from early summer until fall.

False Indigo

Baptisia australis

36-42" x 36-48"

Sun/part shade

Zone 3

Dark blue, pea-like flowers from May to June, followed by black-brown seed pods. Blue-green, compound leaves held upright on strong stems. Adapts to many soil types. Native.
