

BOUTELOUA (BLUE GRAMA GRASS)

Location: Zone 4, sun to part shade, well-drained soil

Shape: Upright, rounded

Foliage: Blue-green, tan in fall

Flowers: Summer through winter

Notes: This native grass has attractive blue-green foliage and striking golden-blond seed heads from June through winter. Low maintenance and tolerant of many soil types but prefers well-drained soil.

Blonde Ambition

Bouteloua gracilis 'Blonde Ambition' PP 22,048

36" x 30-36"

Sun/part shade

Zone 4

Blue-green foliage forms an upright, rounded clump. Foliage turns tan in the fall with golden-blond seed heads. Prefers well-drained soil.
