

CHELONE (TURTLEHEAD)

Location: Zone 3-4, sun to part shade

Shape: Dense, upright clump

Foliage: Dark green

Flowers: Late summer to fall

Notes: Its erect stems end in spikes of white or pink flowers, the shape of which suggests a turtle head. Plants prefer rich, consistently moist soil.

Hot Lips

Chelone lyonii 'Hot Lips'

20-24" x 24"

Sun/part shade Zone 4

New green foliage is tinted bronze then maturing to dark green. Erect stems hold up hooded, dark pink flowers from August to October. Prefers rich, moist soil.



Tiny Tortuga

Chelone lyonii 'Armtipp02' PP 25,350

15-18" x 12-15"

Sun/part shade Zone 4

A dwarf variety with large, deep pink flowers that bloom from August to October. Dark, glossy green foliage has reddish stems and forms a compact clump.
