

GAILLARDIA (BLANKET FLOWER)

Location: Zone 3-4, sun, drought tolerant

Shape: Clump or mound

Foliage: Green to gray-green

Flowers: Mid summer to fall

Notes: Blanket Flowers are valuable in the summer border for their very long season of bloom. Plants form a low mound of light-green leaves, bearing upright stems of large daisy-type flowers. Heat & drought tolerant.

Arizona Apricot *Gaillardia aristata 'Arizona Apricot'*

12" x 12" Full Sun Zone 3

Large, apricot colored, daisy-like flowers bloom continuously from June to September. Green foliage forms a mound. Prefers well-drained soil.



Arizona Red Shades *Gaillardia aristata 'Arizona Red Shades'*

10-12" x 12" Full Sun Zone 3

Large, crimson red, daisy-like flowers bloom continuously from June to August. Green foliage forms a compact, uniform clump. Does best in well-drained soil.



Arizona Sun *Gaillardia grandiflora 'Arizona Sun'*

10" x 12" Full Sun Zone 3

Daisy-like flowers have mahogany-red centers and yellow petal edges and bloom from June through August. Gray-green foliage forms a dense, uniform clump.
