

HYDRANGEA

Annabelle

Hydrangea arborescens 'Annabelle'

4-5' x 3-5'

Sun/shade Zone 3

Rounded form with large, round, white flowers from June to September. Large, dark green leaves can handle heavy pruning in late fall or early spring. Prefers acidic soil and regular watering until roots are established.



BloomStruck®

Hydrangea macrophylla 'PIIHM-II' PP 25,566

3' x 4'

Sun/part shade Zone 4

Strong stems support large mophead blooms all summer. Blooms are purple-blue in acidic soil and pink in alkaline soil. Glossy green leaves have red veins and petioles and turn burgundy red in fall. Winter dieback is common in colder climates.



Bobo®

Hydrangea paniculata 'ILVBO' PP 22,782

3' x 3-4'

Sun/part shade Zone 3

Dwarf, rounded habit with green foliage. Sturdy stems hold large white blooms in July, turning blush pink in fall. Adaptable to many soils. Best when pruned in late fall or early spring.



Early Evolution

Hydrangea paniculata 'AJ14' PP 30,983

1-2' x 1-2'

Sun/part shade Zone 4

This compact hydrangea is covered with buds in early spring; followed by flowers that start lime-white before turning pure white, then blush as they age, ending up dark pink by September.



Endless Summer® The Original *Hydrangea macrophylla 'Bailmer' PP 15,298*

3-5' x 3-5'

Sun/part shade Zone 4

Large flowers have pink blooms in alkaline soils and blue blooms in acidic soil that go all summer. Flowers on old and new wood. Green foliage turns bronze in the fall. Winter dieback is common in colder climates.



Fire Light®

Hydrangea paniculata 'SMHIPFL' PP 25,135

4-6' x 4-6'

Sun/part shade Zone 3

Thick, sturdy, upright stems support large blooms that do not droop. Large flowers start out white to pale pink in mid summer and turn a rich dark red by fall. Foliage is medium green and has an upright growth habit.



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Fire Light Tidbit®

Hydrangea paniculata 'SMNHPK' PP 32,512

2-3' x 2-3'

Sun/part shade Zone 3

An upright, compact mound with strong, sturdy stems that hold up the big, lush panicles of white mopheads. As the summer progresses, the flowers develop bright pink and red tones. Colorful fall foliage.



Incrediball®

Hydrangea arborescens 'Incrediball' PP 20,571

4-5' x 4-5'

Sun/part shade Zone 3

Sturdy branches are strong enough to support the massive, white, mophead blooms. Flowers from July through fall. Green foliage on an upright form. Prefers moist, well-drained soil. Prune in early spring.



Invincibelle® Ruby

Hydrangea arborescens 'NCHA3' PP 28,317

2-3' x 3'

Sun/part shade Zone 3

Strong stems on a mounded form with dark burgundy red flower buds that open to two-toned bright ruby red and silvery pink flowers. Dark green, clean foliage. Improved Invincibelle® Spirit.



Invincibelle Wee White®

Hydrangea arborescens 'NCHA5' PP 30,296

15-24" x 15-24"

Sun/part shade Zone 3

This truly dwarf cultivar naturally grows as a tidy, rounded mound with dark green foliage. From summer to fall it displays pure white mophead blooms held upright on strong stems. Hardy and durable.



Lava Lamp™ Flare™

Hydrangea paniculata 'Kolmavesu' PP 26,928

2-3' x 2-3'

Sun/part shade Zone 3

Compact, dwarf mound of green foliage and large white flowers that turn a fiery red-pink as they mature. The flowers resemble a lava lamp or cone shape. Low maintenance and long bloom time.



Limelight

Hydrangea paniculata 'Zwijnenburg'

6-8' x 6-8'

Sun/part shade Zone 3

Large, upright rounded form with lime green, fragrant flowers in late summer, develops shades of pink, burgundy and green in fall. Green foliage. One of the cold hardiest hydrangeas. Tolerates harsh sites.



HYDRANGEA

Little Lime®

Hydrangea paniculata 'Jane' PP 22,330

3-4' x 3-4'

Sun/part shade Zone 3

Dwarf form of Limelight that stays compact and rounded. Strong stems hold up huge blooms of lime green that change to shades of pink and burgundy in the fall. Prune in late winter or early spring.



Lime Lime Punch®

Hydrangea paniculata 'SMNHPH' PP 33,207

3-5' x 3-5'

Sun/part shade Zone 3

Petite, compact growth habit with flowers that progressively change from the bottom up in a stunning array of white, light pink, and rich punch red. Reblooms throughout the summer.



Little Quick Fire®

Hydrangea paniculata 'SMHPLQ' PP 25,136

3-5' x 3-5'

Sun/part shade Zone 3

More compact form with flowers that emerge bright white and darken from pink and then to red as they age. Earlier, longer bloom time (June-fall) than other varieties. Green foliage on a dwarf, compact form.



Pop Star®

Hydrangea macrophylla 'Bailmacsix' PP 33,703

2' x 2'

Sun/part shade Zone 4

Thick, dark green leaves on a compact, versatile mound. Blooms pink in alkaline soil and blue in acidic soil. Quick to rebloom, forming buds four weeks after shearing. Winter die-back is common in zone 4.



Puffer Fish®

Hydrangea paniculata 'NCHP1' PP 35,316

3-5' x 3-5'

Sun/part shade Zone 3

A larger, more puffed up Bobo®, with fluffy pure white blooms that age to lime green. Flowers from mid summer to frost on strong, upright stems. It has a tight, compact, upright habit and a rapid growth rate.



Quick Fire®

Hydrangea paniculata 'Bulk' PP 16,812

6-8' x 5-6'

Sun/part shade Zone 3

Growth habit is upright and rounded and responds well to annual pruning in either late fall or early spring. Beginning in June, flowers emerge a bright white and darken to pink and finally turning red by fall.



HYDRANGEA

Quick Fire Fab®

Hydrangea paniculata 'SMNHPM' PP 32,513

6-8' x 5-6'

Sun/part shade Zone 3

Big, showy, white mophead blooms appear in early summer and are held upright by strong, sturdy stems. As the flowers age, they turn blush pink, then bright pink, then red from the bottom up.

Strawberry Sundae®

Hydrangea paniculata 'Rensun' PP 25,438

4-5' x 3-4'

Full Sun Zone 4

Upright and compact growth habit with panicles that emerge creamy white mid summer, then change to pink, and finally to strawberry red. Blooms from July-September, red color lasts 3 to 4 weeks.

Summer Crush®

Hydrangea macrophylla 'Mailmacfive' PP 30,359

2-3' x 2-3'

Sun/part shade Zone 4

Raspberry-red, everblooming, mophead flowers on a round, compact form. Foliage is a dark, glossy green and is wilt resistant. Blooms on new and old wood. Mulch well after the ground is frozen. Winter dieback is common in zone 4.
