HIBISCUS

Location: Zone 4, sun, rich, moist, soil

Shape: Upright, rounded, bushy

Foliage: Green or Burgundy

Flowers: Summer to Fall

Notes: Hibiscus prefer full sun and good air circulation. Plant in consistently moist, welldrained soil. May be slow to emerge in spring, gaining vigor with hot weather. Mulch in winter for best results.

Huge, light pink flowers with a red eye and veins bloom from July to August. Foliage is copper red in color and contrasts nicely with flowers. Slow to emerge in spring.

Deep wine-purple, maple-like foliage is combined with 8-9" scarlet red flowers from midsummer into early fall. Late to emerge in spring, but catch up quickly.
