

# LILAC

## **Bloomerang® Dark Purple** *Syringa 'SMSJBP7' PP 26,549*

4-5' x 4-5'                      Full Sun                      Zone 3

Dwarf in stature with a compact, mounded growth habit. Lavender-blue, ultra fragrant flowers are heaviest in spring, then rebloom throughout the summer and into the fall. Good powdery mildew and deer resistance.



## **Charles Joly** *Syringa vulgaris 'Charles Joly'*

8-12' x 8-10'                      Full Sun                      Zone 3

Earlier blooming French hybrid that bears smaller panicles of purple buds that turn to magenta double flowers as they open. Larger, upright that doesn't sucker, making it easier to maintain. Prune after flowering.



## **Common Purple** *Syringa vulgaris*

12-15' x 8-12'                      Full Sun                      Zone 2

Growth habit is upright and vase-shaped with extremely fragrant, purple flowers in May. Blue-green foliage is prone to suckering. Prune after flowering to maintain shade. Popular choice for screening.



## **Common White** *Syringa vulgaris alba*

12-15' x 8-12'                      Full Sun                      Zone 2

Hardy, vigorous, white flowering version of the old-fashioned favorite. Fragrant flowers and attractive blue-green foliage makes a great informal hedge or screen. Prone to suckering, maintain through regular pruning.



## **Donald Wyman** *Syringa x prestoniae 'Donald Wyman'*

8-10' x 4-8'                      Full Sun                      Zone 2

A superb, non-suckering specimen with dark green leaves and an upright, rounded growth habit. Purple buds open to single, fragrant, pink-lilac flower clusters in spring, two weeks after common varieties.



## **Dwarf Korean** *Syringa meyeri 'Palibin'*

4-5' x 5-7'                      Full Sun                      Zone 3

Dwarf variety with excellent uniform habit and red-purple buds that open to single, pale lilac flowers. Fragrant flowers attract hummingbirds and butterflies. Small, green foliage is extremely resistant to powdery mildew, as well as, deer resistant.



# LILAC

## **Little Lady™**

*Syringa × Jeflady' PP 30,331*

4-5' x 4-5'

Full Sun

Zone 2

Rounded and compact growth habit with fragrant, lilac-pink flowers in the spring. Wavy, bright green foliage turns a rich dark red in the fall. Perfect for foundation plantings or informal hedges. Very cold hardy.

## **Miss Kim**

*Syringa patula 'Miss Kim'*

4-6' x 4-5'

Full Sun

Zone 3

Compact, rounded shape with purple buds that open to single, fragrant, pale lilac flowers when other lilacs have finished. It has larger leaves and beautiful burgundy-red fall color. Prefers moist, well-drained soil.



## **Sensation**

*Syringa vulgaris 'Sensation'*

8-10' x 8-12'

Full Sun

Zone 3

Single purple florets with a distinctive pure white border adorn this medium-large lilac each May. An outstanding and unique selection with erect and open branching and rich green foliage. Drought tolerant.



## **Virtual Violet®**

*Syringa 'Bailbridget' PP 30,286*

6-8' x 5-7'

Full Sun

Zone 3

New leaves on this well-branched, upright lilac are shiny violet with deep purple stems; flower buds are raspberry-purple and open to fragrant violet flowers. Leaf petioles remain violet into the summer and are remarkably mildew free.
