

Actaea/Cimicifuga

Location: Zone 4, sun to part shade

Shape: Upright

Foliage: Bronze-purple

Flowers: Mid to late summer

Notes: Bottlebrush flowers are very fragrant. Does best in consistently moist soil. Good plant for woodland gardens. Plants will take about three years to develop into a mature clump. Commonly referred to as Snakeroot or Bugbane.

Zone 4

Upright, bronze-purple foliage with the light pink bottlebrush flower spikes from July to September. Flowers are very fragrant. Does best in consistently moist soil.
