

Allium (Ornamental Onion)

Location: Zone 4, sun to part shade, drought tolerant

Shape: Mounded clump

Foliage: Grass green, semi-evergreen

Flowers: Mid to late summer

Notes: Grass green foliage is semi-evergreen which makes it a great early spring perennial. Lavender globes appear on stalks above the foliage in June through July. Pest free and deer resistant.

Millenium • *Allium 'Millenium'*

15-20" x 12-15" Sun/part shade Zone 4

Bright rosy purple globes on strong stems are held above the thick, glossy green leaves. It forms a compact clump with fragrant flowers and foliage. Drought tolerant.

Summer Beauty • *Allium tanguticum 'Summer Beauty'*

12-18" x 18-24" Sun/part shade Zone 4

Mounded clumps of green, grass-like foliage is semi-evergreen. Two inch pom-poms of striking lavender blooms are held upright in June and July. Drought tolerant.
