Anemone (Windflower)

Location: Zone 3, part shade, well-drained soil, native

Shape: Compact

Foliage: Green to purplish green

Flowers: Spring

Notes: A native species in the buttercup family that grows vigorously in partly shaded areas.

The name Anemone comes from Greek and roughly means wind flower.

Snowdrop • Anemone sylvestris

12-15" x 12" Part shade Zone 3

Fragrant white flowers with yellow centers bloom from April to June and may rebloom again in the fall. Native; vigorous grower in part shade with well-drained soil.
