Aruncus (Goat's Beard)

Location: Zone 3, sun to part shade, moist sites

Shape: Mounded

Foliage: Lacy or fern-like, dark green, bronze fall color

Flowers: Late spring to early summer

Notes: Similar in appearance to astilbe, but flowers are more feathery. *Aruncus dioicus* is native to North America. Excellent background or border plant in a woodland, wild or native plant garden.

Dwarf Goat's Beard • Aruncus aethusifolius

8-12" x 12" Sun/part shade Zone 3

Dense, low mound of dark green, fern-like foliage and cream colored flower spikes from May to July. Does well in moist sites.

Goat's Beard • Aruncus dioicus

48-60" x 48-60" Sun/part shade Zone 3

Large mound of lacy, dark green foliage with large cream colored plumes in June and July. Does well in moist sites. Native to north America.
