

Bergenia (Pigsqueak)

Location: Zone 4, part sun, tolerates wet sites

Shape: Low mound

Foliage: Large, thick, heartshaped, green turning bronze in fall

Flowers: Spring

Notes: Leathery, heart-shaped leaves have a glossy green color for most of the year and turn red or bronze in the fall. Flowers grow on a stem similar in color to a rhubarb stalk and have pink cone-shaped flowers.

Winter Glow • *Bergenia cordifolia* 'Winterglut'

12-15" x 18" Part sun/shade Zone 3

Low mound of thick, leathery, heart-shaped, glossy green foliage turns deep red in fall. Red stems hold up dark magenta, cone-shaped flowers from March to May.
