Brunnera (False Forget-Me-Not)

Location: Zone 4, part sun to shade

Shape: Mounded

Foliage: Heart shaped, usually green with silver

Flowers: Spring

Notes: Cousins to the Forget-Me-Nots, Brunnera makes for an attractive and versatile groundcover, particularly under shrubs. Clumps may be easily divided in early fall.
