

Chelone (Turtlehead)

Location: Zone 3-4, sun to part shade

Shape: Dense, upright clump

Foliage: Dark green

Flowers: Late summer to fall

Notes: Its erect stems end in spikes of white or pink flowers, the shape of which suggests a turtle head. Plants prefer rich, consistently moist soil.

Hot Lips • *Chelone lyonii* 'Hot Lips'

20-24" x 24" Sun/part shade Zone 4

New green foliage is tinted bronze then maturing to dark green. Erect stems hold up hooded, dark pink flowers from August to October. Prefers rich, moist soil.



Tiny Tortuga • *Chelone lyonii* 'Armtipp02' PP 25,350

15-18" x 12-15" Sun/part shade Zone 4

A dwarf variety with large, deep pink flowers that bloom from August to October. Dark, glossy green foliage has reddish stems and forms a compact clump.
