Einstein™ • Clethra Novacleein' PP 27,590

3-4' x 3-4' Sun/Shade Zone 4

Twisted strands of long white flowers emit a sweet fragrance that is especially attractive to pollinators. Lush green foliage grows in a rounded, compact form. Fall color is a golden brown. Does well in heavier soils.



Ruby Spice • Clethra alnifolia 'Ruby Spice'

3-5' x 3-4' Sun/Shade Zone 4

Bright rose-pink flowers on 4" spikes bloom for weeks in the summer on an upright, mounded form. Blue-green leaves turn yellow in the fall. An important nectar source for butterflies and bees. Tolerates wet sites.



Sixteen Candles • Clethra alnifolia 'Sixteen Candles'

4' x 2-3' Sun/Shade Zone 4

Creamy white, candle-like spikes are 6" tall and extremely fragrant when they bloom in mid-summer. Rounded growth habit with dark green leaves that turn yellow in fall. Best in moist, acidic soil.



Sugartina® • Clethra alnifolia 'Crystallina' PP 21,561

2-3' x 2-3' Sun/Shade Zone 4

Compact, rounded form that needs little pruning to maintain its shape. Very fragrant pure white flowers attract butterflies in mid-summer. Dark glossy green foliage turns yellow in fall. Tolerates wet sites.
