Coreopsis (Tickseed)

Location: Zone 3-4, sun

Shape: Mounded

Foliage: Green

Flowers: Summer to fall

Notes: Coreopsis are great additions to any garden design, blooming most of the summer, especially when deadheaded. Coreopsis make great garden edging as well as nice cut flowers.

Early Sunrise • Coreopsis grandiflora 'Early Sunrise'

18-24" x 18-24" Full Sun Zone 3

Large daisy-like, golden yellow flowers are prolific all summer. Multiple blooms when dead-headed. Forms clumps of green foliage.



Moonbeam • Coreopsis verticillata 'Moonbeam'

18" x 18-24" Full Sun Zone 3

A loose mound of daisy-like, lemon yellow flowers bloom repeatedly from June through September. Thread-leaf foliage is light green.



Sunstar[™] Orange • Coreopsis verticillata 'TNCORSO' PPAF

18-24" x 24-30" Full Sun Zone 4

Large, vivid, citrus-hued, red-splashed, sun-loving blooms from late spring through summer. Feathery, mildew resistant foliage.



Sunstar[™] Rose • Coreopsis verticillata 'Sunstar Rose' PPAF

18-24" x 24-30" Full Sun Zone 4

Tidy, feathery green foliage is covered with creamy white-tipped, rose-pink flowers from June through August. Has excellent resistance to mildew.



Zagreb • Coreopsis verticillata 'Zagreb'

15-18" x 18" Full Sun Zone 3

Golden daisy-like flowers top light green thread-leaf foliage from June through October. Forms a tight mound.
