Dianthus (Pinks)

Location: Zone 3, sun, well-drained soil

Shape: Creeping, low growing mound

Foliage: Green to blue-green, grass-like

Flowers: Late spring to late summer

Notes: Good rock garden or border plant. Flowers are bright and fragrant. After the flowers

have died, cut the stems to ground level. Dianthus will not tolerate wet soils.

Fire Witch • Dianthus gratianopolitanus 'Firewitch'

8" x 12" Full Sun Zone 4

Fragrant, bright magenta flowers bloom from May to July. Foliage has a blue hue and forms a thick mound. Prefers rich, well-drained soil.



Frosty Fire • Dianthus 'Frosty Fire'

6" x 9" Full Sun Zone 3

Double red flowers stand slightly taller than the blue-green foliage. Blooms from May to June and foliage has evergreen qualities. Does best in well-drained soil.



Fruit Punch® Cranberry Cocktail • Dianthus 'Cranberry Cocktail' PP 28,603

8-10" x 12-14" Sun/part shade Zone 4

Double hot pink, carnation-like flowers bloom from June to August. Grey-green foliage forms a dense mound.



Mountain Frost™ Red Garnet • Dianthus 'KonD1335K1' PP 32,362

6-8" x 10-12" Full sun Zone 4

Deep red flowers bloom all summer atop a low growing, silver-blue mound of grass-like foliage. Drought tolerant.



Mountain Frost Ruby Glitter • Dianthus 'KonD1400K6' PP 33,461

8-10" x 8-10" Full sun Zone 4

Fragrant, red blooms with creamy white blotches rebloom all season atop tidy mounds or silvery green foliage. Tolerates wet or dry soil.

Flowers are hot pink flecked with gold and bloom from May to August. Powdery blue foliage forms a dense mound. Prefers well-drained soil.
