## **New Harmony** • *Ulmus americana* 'New Harmony'

60-70' x 60-65'      Full sun      Zone 4

Upright arching limbs and a graceful vase shape. Foliage is glossy dark green that turns yellow in the fall. It has shown great resistance to Dutch Elm Disease, elm leaf miner and elm leaf beetle. Drought tolerant.



## **Prairie Expedition**<sup>®</sup> • *Ulmus americana* 'Lewis & Clark'

50-60' x 50-60'      Full sun      Zone 2

Broad, rounded to spreading vase-shaped habit. Lustrous dark green leaves turn yellow in fall. Extremely cold hardy, fast growing, and disease resistant. Tolerant of both wet and dry soil conditions.



## **Princeton** • *Ulmus americana* 'Princeton'

60' x 40'      Full sun      Zone 3

Upright, vase-shape forms an overhead arch. Dark green leaves turn a rich golden yellow in the fall. It is very hardy and extremely adaptable. Fast growing and disease resistant.



## **St. Croix**<sup>™</sup> • *Ulmus americana* 'St. Croix' PP20,097

60-75' x 70-90'      Full sun      Zone 3

Grand, vase-shaped with an open, spreading canopy, and beautiful dark green foliage that turns a wonderful yellow in the fall. Dutch Elm Disease resistant.
