## **Eupatorium (Joe Pye Weed)**

**Location:** Zone 2-4, sun to part shade

**Shape:** Upright

**Foliage:** Green to Chocolate

Flowers: Summer to fall

**Notes:** A native perennial which is long blooming and a very showy, tall, border plant good for large gardens. Grow in moist, well-drained soil for best results. A favorite of butterflies!

## Baby Joe • Eupatorium dubium 'Baby Joe'

24-36" x 18-30" Sun/part shade Zone 4

Showy, lavender-rose flowers bloom from July to September. Upright bright green foliage is shorter in stature than the species. Attracts butterflies and is drought tolerant.
