

Eupatorium (Joe Pye Weed)

Location: Zone 2-4, sun to part shade

Shape: Upright

Foliage: Green to Chocolate

Flowers: Summer to fall

Notes: A native perennial which is long blooming and a very showy, tall, border plant good for large gardens. Grow in moist, well-drained soil for best results. A favorite of butterflies!

Baby Joe • *Eupatorium dubium* 'Baby Joe'

24-36" x 18-30" Sun/part shade Zone 4

Showy, lavender-rose flowers bloom from July to September. Upright bright green foliage is shorter in stature than the species. Attracts butterflies and is drought tolerant.
