

Euphorbia (Cushion Spruge)

Location: Zone 4, part sun to shade

Shape: Compact mound

Foliage: Gray-green, red tones in fall

Flowers: Spring to summer

Notes: Electric yellow bracts bloom on a low cushion in April and persist, but gently fade as the stems elongate to form a 16" mound by midsummer. The leaves produce shades of red, orange, and purple in autumn.

Bonfire • *Euphorbia polychrome* 'Bonfire' PP 18,585 COPF

12-15" x 18-24" Sun/part shade Zone 4

Electric yellow bracts bloom on a low cushion from May to June. Uniform mound of green foliage turns deep red with yellow tips. Drought tolerant.
