Heuchera (Coral Bells)

Location: Zone 3-4, sun to part shade

Shape: Mounded

Foliage: Lobed, usually ruffled, wide variety of colors

Flowers: Spring or summer

Notes: Small, delicate flowers grow on wiry stems above basal foliage. Heucheras are many grown for their foliage, not the flower. Best used as a border plant, specimen or ground cover.

18-20" x 18-20" Part sun/shade Zone 4

Round lobed foliage is rose-pink turning bronze-red and has a mounded growth habit. Small, bell-shaped ivory flowers bloom in June and are held above the foliage on wiry stems.

Caramel • Heuchera 'Caramel' PP 16,562

10-12" x 12-18" Part sun Zone 4

Golden orange to apricot foliage forms a mound with upright stalks or small, light pink flowers in June and July. Heat and humidity tolerant.

Citronelle • Heuchera 'Citronelle' PP 17,934

10-12" x 12-14" Part sun/shade Zone 4

Mounds of lime-yellow foliage with silvery undersides have cream colored flowers from May to July. Prefers rich, well-drained soil.

Crimson Curls • Heuchera 'Crimson Curls' PP 13,729

12-15" x 15-18" Part sun Zone 3

Very ruffled, wide, purple foliage with small, white flowers from June through September. Forms a compact mound.

Fire Alarm • Heuchera 'Fire Alarm' PP 24,525

9" x 14" Part sun/shade Zone 4

Foliage is bright red in spring and darkens to mahogany in summer. Pinkish-white flowers on red stems bloom June to August.

Frosted Violet • Heuchera 'Frosted Violet'

10-14" x 10-12"

Zone 3

Rounded, lobed, new leaves emerge pink-purple in spring, turning burgundy-violet. Light pink flowers appear above the foliage in June and July.

Midnight Rose • Heuchera 'Midnight Rose' PP 18,551

10" x 24"

Zone 4

Spreading mound of dark purple foliage with bright pink specks is topped with small, white flowers in spring.

Zone 4

Round amber leaves form a dense mound. Small, yellow flowers are held above the foliage in May and June. Prefers well-drained soil.

Ruffled, maroon-black leaves with red undersides form a dense mound. Foliage remains fresh late into the season. Tall, dainty white flowers bloom from May to June.

Palace Purple • Heuchera micrantha 'Palace Purple'

Ivy-like, deep mahogany-red foliage forms a large mound. Small white flowers bloom from May to June. Larger in leaf and stature, hardier, and more sun tolerant than others.

Green foliage with silver overlay and deep rose pink flowers that bloom from May to July. Flowers are showier and stand out against the foliage.

Shiny, dark purple foliage with a silver overlay and small white flowers bloom in June and July. Forms an upright mound.
