

Heucherella (Foamy Bells)

Location: Zone 4, best in part shade

Shape: Low mound, upright flower stalks

Foliage: Bright yellow with beet red veins

Flowers: Late spring to early summer

Notes: A cross between Heuchera (Coral Bells) and Tiarella (Foam Flower.) Tall white flower stalks bloom above stunning bright foliage. Use as groundcovers, edging, foliage plants or accents in large containers.

Pink Revolution • Heucherella 'Pink Revolution' PPAF

16-20" x 12-14" Part sun Zone 4

Deeply lobed, green foliage with burgundy veins topped with upright, bubblegum pink flower stalks in May and June. A prolific bloomer; prefers well-drained soil.



Solar Eclipse • Heucherella 'Solar Eclipse' PP 23,647

10-12" x 16-18" Part sun Zone 4

Deeply scalloped, reddish-brown foliage with lime green border has a mounded growth habit. White flowers bloom from May to June. Prefers well-drained soil.



Stoplight • Heucherella 'Stoplight' PP 16,835

14-16" x 12" Part sun Zone 4

Bright yellow leaves with beet red veins and form a low mound. Small white flowers on upright stalks bloom from May to June.



Tapestry • Heucherella 'Tapestry' PP 21,150

12-16" x 20" Part sun/shade Zone 4

Mounded foliage is green with dark centers and a blue iridescence. Pink, upright flower stalks are held above foliage from May through August.
