

Hibiscus

Location: Zone 4, sun, rich, moist, soil

Shape: Upright, rounded, bushy

Foliage: Green or Burgundy

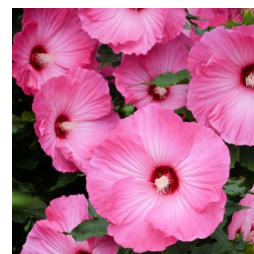
Flowers: Summer to Fall

Notes: Hibiscus prefer full sun and good air circulation. Plant in consistently moist, well-drained soil. May be slow to emerge in spring, gaining vigor with hot weather. Mulch in winter for best results.

Airbrush Effect • *Hibiscus 'Airbrush Effect'* PP 29,295

42-48" x 48-54" Sun/part shade Zone 4

Flowers are vibrant pink with a salmon hue and a white halo around a dark red eye. Blooms July through September on an upright, mounded bush. Plant in moist, well-drained soil.



Cranberry Punch® • *Hibiscus moscheutos 'Whit XX'*

24-36" x 24-36" Full Sun Zone 4

Dark red flowers bloom all summer. Deep green, red-veined leaves form a tidy, compact, dense mound. It is heat and drought tolerant.



Cristi™ • *Hibiscus moscheutos 'Cocker'* PPAF

48-72" x 36-48" Full Sun Zone 4

Huge ruby red flowers bloom from August to September on a bushy, rounded form. Tolerant of urban conditions. Late to break bud, typically in June.



Kopper King • *Hibiscus 'Kopper King'* PP 10,793

36-48" x 36-48" Full Sun Zone 4

Huge, light pink flowers with a red eye and veins bloom from July to August. Foliage is copper red in color and contrasts nicely with flowers. Slow to emerge in spring.



Midnight Marvel • *Hibiscus 'Midnight Marvel'* PP 24,079

46-48" x 52-54" Full Sun Zone 4

Deep wine-purple, maple-like foliage is combined with 8-9" scarlet red flowers from midsummer into early fall. Late to emerge in spring, but catch up quickly.

Moonshadow™ Morello • *Hibiscus moscheutos* 'G19163'

42-48" x 42-48" Full sun/light shade Zone 4/5

Large, light pink flowers with dark pink veining. Blooms from July through September. Foliage is lobed and almost black in color.



Moonshadow™ Rosita • *Hibiscus moscheutos* 'G19164'

42-48" x 42-48" Full sun/light shade Zone 4/5

Huge raspberry-red blooms contrast against the dark, purple-black foliage on a densely branched, compact plant. It emerges 2-3 weeks earlier than other hibiscus. Improved tolerance to Japanese Beetles. Full sun for best foliage color.



Starry Starry Night • *Hibiscus* 'Starry Starry Night' PP 27,901

42-48" x 42-48" Full sun Zone 4

Rose-red centers spiral out along the veins among the broad pale pink petals of giant blooms. Dark mocha foliage emerges 2-3 weeks earlier than other hibiscus. Improved tolerance to Japanese Beetles. Full sun for best foliage color.
