

Leucanthemum (Shasta Daisy)

Location: Zone 3-4, sun to part shade

Shape: Mounded

Foliage: Dark green, toothed

Flowers: Summer to fall

Notes: These daisy-like flowers are long blooming and often rebloom if deadheaded. Shasta daisies prefer fertile, well-drained soil and are intolerant of wet or poorly drained soil. Divide clumps every few years.

Banana Cream • *Leucanthemum superbum* 'Banana Cream'

15-18" x 15-18" Sun/part shade Zone 4

Compact clump of dark green, disease resistant foliage is topped with daisy-like blooms from June through August. Flowers are lemon yellow with a gold eye.

Becky • *Leucanthemum x superbum* 'Becky'

36" x 18-24" Sun/part shade Zone 4

Dark green, toothed foliage forms an upright mound and is covered with daisy-like flowers from June through September. Flowers are white with a yellow cone center.



Snowcap • *Leucanthemum x superbum* 'Snowcap'

10-14" x 12-15" Sun/light shade Zone 4

Dwarf mound of dark green foliage is topped with white blooms with a yellow cone center in June and July. Prefers fertile, well-drained soil.
