

Liatris (Gayfeather)

Location: Zone 3, sun, drought tolerant

Shape: Upright

Foliage: Narrow, green

Flowers: Summer to fall

Notes: Liatris, also known as Blazing Star or Gayfeather, thrives in the heat, and sends up tall feathery stalks of bright pink-purple or white flowers from attractive grassy tufts of foliage in mid summer. Attracts butterflies.

Floristan Violet • *Liatris spicata* 'Floristan Violet'

30-36" x 18" Full sun Zone 3

Long, rosy-purple flower spikes bloom from June through September. Taller than Kobold. Drought and heat tolerant.



Floristan White • *Liatris spicata* 'Floristan White'

36" x 20-24" Full Sun Zone 3

Tall, feathery, white flower spikes bloom from June to September. Attractive grassy tufts of green foliage grows in an upright clump. Heat and drought tolerant.



Kobold • *Liatris spicata* 'Kobold'

18-24" x 18" Full Sun Zone 3

Tall feathery stalks of lilac-purple bloom atop attractive grassy green tufts of foliage from July through September. Attracts butterflies and is heat and drought tolerant.
