Ligularia

Location: Zone 4, prefers part shade, moist soil

Shape: Mounded, clumping

Foliage: Light green to bronze-green

Flowers: Late summer to fall

Notes: Ligularia needs consistently moist soil and afternoon shade to thrive. It has large leaves and yellow flowers that are either daisy-like or tall spires.

Britt Marie Crawford • Ligularia dentata 'Britt Marie Crawford'

36-48" x 24-36" Part sun Zone 4

Daisy-like flowers are golden orange and bloom in August and September. Toothed, chocolate-maroon colored foliage forms a large clumping mound. Thrives in cool, moist sites.

Desdemona • Ligularia dentata 'Desdemona'

36-42" x 24-30" Sun/shade Zone 4

Grown for its dark colored foliage and its orange, daisy-like flowers. Features huge, leathery, toothed, heart-shaped, leaves that are bronze-green on top and purplish beneath.

Little Rocket • Ligularia stenocephala 'Little Rocket' PP 14,621

36-48" x 24" Part sun Zone 4

Bright yellow flower spikes grow on tall stalks in June and July. Large, bronze green, serrated foliage is very coarse textured and forms a mounded clump. Best in cool, moist sites.

Othello • Ligularia dentata 'Othello'

36-42" x 24-30" Sun/shade Zone 4

Large, bronze-green leaves have purple undersides and stems and form a mounded clump. Yellow-orange, daisy-like flowers bloom from August to Sept. Prefers moist soil.

The Rocket • Ligularia stenocephala 'The Rocket'

48-60" x 36-48" Sun/part shade Zone 4

Tall, yellow flower spikes bloom in June and July. Huge, toothed, light green leaves have purple stems and are 12 inches across. Thrives in cool, moist sites.
