

Lilium Asiatic (Asiatic Lily)

Location: Zone 3, sun to part shade, moist, well-drained soil

Shape: Upright

Foliage: Green, narrow, sword-like

Flowers: Summer

Notes: Asiatic lilies are among the easiest to grow. They're very hardy, need no staking, and are not particularly fussy about soil, as long as it drains well. Flowers are trumpet shaped and come in a wide range of colors.

Tiny Bee • *Lilium asiatic* 'Tiny Bee' PP 16,255

12-14" x 12-14" Sun/part shade Zone 3

Yellow, trumpet shaped flowers bloom in June and July. Upright clump of narrow, sword-like, green foliage. Very hardy, needs no staking, and easy to grow in well-drained soil.



Tiny Ghost • *Lilium asiatic* 'Tiny Ghost' PP 16,161

12-14" x 12-14" Sun/part shade Zone 3

Burgundy, trumpet shaped flowers bloom in June and July. Upright clump of narrow, sword-like, green foliage. Very hardy, needs no staking, and does well in well-drained soil.



Tiny Ink • *Lilium asiatic* 'Tiny Ink' PPAF

14-16" x 10-12" Sun/part shade Zone 3

Red petals with burgundy centers bloom in June and July. Upright clump of narrow, sword-like, green foliage. Very hardy, needs no staking, and does well in well-drained soil.



Tiny Invader • *Lilium asiatic* 'Tiny Invader' PP 17,618

12-14" x 10-12" Sun/part shade Zone 3

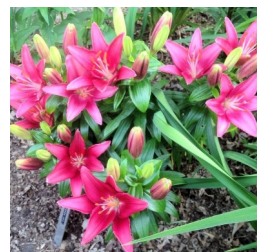
Flowers are bright orange with purple freckles and bloom in June and July. Upright clump of narrow, sword-like, green foliage. Needs no staking; prefers moist, well-drained soil.



Tiny Pear • *Lilium asiatic* 'Tiny Pearl' PP 22,874

14-16" x 10-12" Sun/part shade Zone 3

Rich pink, trumpet shaped flowers bloom in June and July. Upright clump of narrow, sword-like, green foliage. Very hardy, needs no staking, and does well in well-drained soil.



Lilium Asiatic (Asiatic Lily)

Tiny Rocket • *Lilium asiatic* 'Tiny Rocket' PPAF

14-16" x 10-12" Sun/part shade Zone 3

Dark red, trumpet shaped flowers bloom in June and July. Upright clump of narrow, sword-like, green foliage. Very hardy, needs no staking, and prefers moist, well-drained soil.



Lilium (Oriental Lily)

Location: Zone 2-4, sun to part shade, moist, well-drained soil

Shape: Upright

Foliage: Green, sword-like, wider than Asiatic hybrids

Flowers: Summer, very fragrant

Notes: Oriental lilies have become increasingly popular, due to their large, exotic (often frilly) blooms and heavy, sweet perfume. Their flowers and foliage are larger than the Asiatic hybrids.

Casa Blanca • *Lilium* 'Casa Blanca'

32-40" x 12" Sun/part shade Zone 4

Large white flowers are very fragrant in July and August. Green, sword-like foliage is wider than Asiatic hybrids. Prefers moist, well-drained soil.



Stargazer • *Lilium* 'Stargazer'

24-32" x 24" Sun/part shade Zone 2

Heavily perfumed, large, bright pink flowers have white margins and dark spotting; blooms midsummer. Green foliage is wide and sword-like. Prefers moist, well-drained soil.



Lilium Lancifolium (Tiger Lily)

Location: Zone 3, sun to part shade, well-drained soil

Shape: Upright

Foliage: Green, sword-like, wider than Asiatic hybrids

Flowers: Late summer to early fall

Notes: *Lilium lancifolium* is an Asian species of lily, native to China, Japan, Korea, and the Russian Far East. It is widely planted as an ornamental because of its showy orange-and-black flowers, and has become naturalized in numerous scattered locations in eastern North America.

Splendens • *Lilium lancifolium* 'Splendens'

32-48" x 9-12"

Sun/part shade

Zone 3

Showy, reddish orange flowers with black spots bloom from August through September. Green, lance-shaped foliage grows in an upright form. Grows best in well-drained soil.
