

Lobelia

Location: Zone 3-4, part shade, moist, well-drained soil

Shape: Upright to mounded

Foliage: Green to burgundy

Flowers: Summer to fall

Notes: Lobelia grows native along streambeds. It thrives in areas where other perennials would rot and adds bold color to shady corners of the garden. Long blooming flowers attract hummingbirds.

Cardinal Flower • *Lobelia cardinalis*

36-48" x 24-36" Part sun Zone 3

Tall, scarlet red flowers bloom from June to August and attract hummingbirds. Green foliage has an upright growth habit. Tolerates wet sites. Native.



Great Blue • *Lobelia siphilitica* 'Great Blue'

24-36" x 24-36" Part sun Zone 3

Tall blue flower spikes are long blooming from July to September and attract hummingbirds. Mounded, bright green foliage thrives in moist, well-drained soil. Native.
