

Lupinus (Lupine)

Location: Zone 4, sun to part shade, rich, well-drained soil

Shape: Upright, clump forming

Foliage: Bushy, bright green, whorls

Flowers: Late spring to summer

Notes: Lupines produce spikes of pea-like flowers available in a myriad of colors. Trim foliage back after flowering. These are biennial or short-lived perennials, allow some plants to set seed for future generations.

Staircase™ Blue • *Lupinus polyphyllus* 'Staircase Blue'

18-24" x 18-24" Full sun Zone 4

Dense, lavender-blue flower spikes stand upright from May to June above bushy, bright green foliage. It has a compact, upright habit. Prefers slightly acidic, well-drained soil.



Staircase™ Red • *Lupinus polyphyllus* 'Staircase Red'

18-24" x 18-24" Full sun Zone 4

Large spikes of red, pea-like flowers bloom from May to June. Bright green, whorled foliage grows in compact, upright clumps. Prefers slightly acidic, well-drained soil.
