

Nepeta (Catmint)

Location: Zone 4, sun to part shade

Shape: Mounded

Foliage: Scented, blue-green to gray green

Flowers: Summer to fall

Notes: This member of the mint family is extremely easy growing with few pests or problems. The billowing foliage is topped with spikes of flowers in early summer with repeat blooms throughout the season.

Cat's Pajamas • *Nepeta 'Cat's Pajamas'* PP 31,127

12-14" x 18-20" Full Sun Zone 3

Indigo-blue flower spikes on a dense mound bloom from May to July. Green, mint-scented foliage is disease and pest resistant. Drought tolerant.



Junior Walker • *Nepeta x faassenii 'Junior Walker'* PP 23,074

14-16" x 24-30" Sun/light shade Zone 4

Scented, soft gray-green foliage with lavender-blue flower spikes from June to September. A favorite of bees and butterflies. Drought tolerant.



Walker's Low • *Nepeta x faassenii 'Walker's Low'*

24-26" x 24-30" Sun/light shade Zone 4

Lavender-blue flower spikes bloom from June through September. Mint-scented, soft gray-green foliage has an upright, mounded growth habit. Drought tolerant.
