

# Paeonia (Peony)

**Location:** Zones 2-4, sun to light shade, rich, well-drained soil

**Shape:** Upright mound

**Foliage:** Glossy green

**Flowers:** Late spring to early summer

**Notes:** The blossoms are ordinarily very fragrant and may be single, double or anemone form. The foliage is often tinted bronze when new and takes on reddish tones in the fall.

## **Coral Charm • *Paeonia* × '*Coral Charm*'**

28-36" x 24-30"      Sun/light shade      Zone 3

Semi-double flowers have a unique coral-peach color and bloom from May to June. Forms a mounded clump of glossy, deep green foliage. Best in rich, well-drained soil.



## **Duchesse de Nemours • *Paeonia lactiflora* '*Duchesse de Nemours*'**

32-38" x 30-36"      Sun/light shade      Zone 3

Large and fragrant, the double white flowers have a yellow center and bloom in May. Forms a glossy green, rounded mound. Prefers rich, well-drained soil.



## **Kansas • *Paeonia* × '*Kansas*'**

18-24" x 30"      Sun/light shade      Zone 4

Double, dark pink to red flowers bloom in May and June. Shorter in stature with an upright, mounded growth habit and glossy green foliage. Best in rich, well-drained soil.



## **Karl Rosenfield • *Paeonia lactiflora* '*Karl Rosenfield*'**

32-38" x 30-36"      Sun/light shade      Zone 2

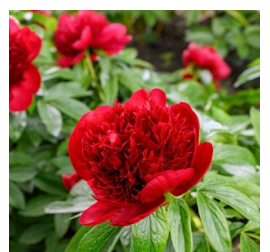
Very large, fragrant, double dark ruby red flowers bloom in May and June. Glossy green foliage forms a rounded, upright mound. Prefers rich, well-drained soil.



## **Red Charm • *Paeonia* × '*Red Charm*'**

36" x 24-36"      Sun/light shade      Zone 3

Double, deep red flowers in late May have a spicy-sweet fragrance. Glossy green foliage form a sturdy mound. One of the earliest bloomers. Prefers rich, well-drained soil.



# Paeonia (Peony)

## **Sarah Bernhardt** • *Paeonia lactiflora* 'Sarah Bernhardt'

32-36" x 30-36"      Sun/light shade      Zone 3

Large and fragrant flowers are a double soft pink with silver tipped petals in June. Glossy green foliage forms an upright mound. Grows best in rich, well-drained soil.



# Paeonia Itoh (Itoh Peony)

**Location:** Zone 4, sun to light shade

**Shape:** Rounded or mounded

**Foliage:** Dark green, toothed

**Flowers:** Late spring to early summer

**Notes:** Itoh peonies resemble tree peonies with a domed, vigorous growth habit and large double flowers. They have disease-resistant lacy, dark green foliage. They can provide up to 50 blooms in a single season. Sturdy stems require no staking.

## **Bartzella™ Itoh** • *Paeonia (Itoh)* 'Bartzella'

30-36" x 30-36"      Sun/light shade      Zone 4

Very large, fragrant, bright yellow double blossoms with a slight red center stand above the lush, disease resistant, dark green foliage. Forms a sturdy clump that doesn't need cage.



## **Cora Louise Itoh** • *Paeonia (Itoh)* x 'Cora Louise'

30-36" x 36-42"      Sun/light shade      Zone 4

Large, semi-double flowers are white with a dark lavender center and are lightly fragrant. Green, toothed foliage grows in a bushy mound. Sturdy stems require no staking.



## **Julia Rose Itoh** • *Paeonia (Itoh)* 'Julia Rose'

24-36" x 24-36"      Sun/light shade      Zone 4

From May to June, large double, soft apricot blooms with red-purple tips and a yellow center cover the rounded, sturdy form. Dark green foliage stays clean all summer.



# Paeonia Itoh (Itoh Peony)

## **Keiko™ Itoh • *Paeonia (Itoh) × Pink Double Dandy***

24-30" x 24-30"

Sun/part shade

Zone 4

Large, lightly fragrant flowers on strong stems above a compact mound of dark green foliage. Dark lavender-pink petals mature to soft pink, revealing a cluster of yellow stamens.



## **Singing in the Rain Itoh • *Paeonia (Itoh) × 'Singing in the Rain'***

24-36" x 36-48"

Sun/part shade

Zone 4

Creamy yellow, semi-double spring blooms become flushed with salmon coloring as they mature. Forms a lush mound of dark green foliage.
