Pulmonaria (Lungwort)

Location: Zone 3, sun to shade, moist, rich, well-drained soil

Shape: Mounded

Foliage: Narrow, green with silver spotting or mottling

Flowers: Spring

Notes: A low growing perennial that often has long, variegated leaves that come in spots or splashes. The small funnel shaped flowers can be very vivid, with some changing color as they mature.

Raspberry Splash • Pulmonaria longifolia 'Raspberry Splash' PP 12,138

12" x 24" Part sun/shade Zone 3

Forms a low growing mound of narrow, upright, green leaves with silver spotting. Bellshapes, raspberry pink flowers bloom in spring. Prefers rich, well-drained soil.

Trevi Fountain • Pulmonaria 'Trevi Fountain' PP 13,047

8-12" x 18-24" Part sun/shade Zone 4

Small, cobalt blue flowers bloom in April and May. Foliage is blue-green with silver spotting and grows in a mounded clump. Best in well-drained soil.
