

# Rudbeckia (Black Eyed Susan)

**Location:** Zone 3-4, sun, heat and drought tolerant

**Shape:** Upright

**Foliage:** Green, rough textured

**Flowers:** Late summer to fall

**Notes:** Tough, long blooming perennial that are easy to establish. They have a daisy-like flower with gold petals and a dark center seed head. The foliage on Rudbeckia is scratchy and hairy.

## **American Gold Rush • *Rudbeckia 'American Gold Rush'* PP 28,498**

18-24" x 24-30"      Full Sun      Zone 3

Daisy-like golden-yellow flowers with black centers continuously bloom from July through September. Rough, green foliage is fungus and leaf spot resistant even in wet sites.



## **Goldsturm • *Rudbeckia fulgida 'Goldsturm'***

22-26" x 18-24"      Full Sun      Zone 3

Green, rough textured foliage has an upright habit and is topped with golden yellow, daisy-like flowers with a black cone from July through Sept. Heat and drought tolerant.



## **Little Goldstar • *Rudbeckia fulgida var. sullivantii 'Little Goldstar'***

14-16" x 14-16"      Sun/light shade      Zone 4

A profusion of golden-yellow, starburst shaped flowers bloom from July to September. A dwarf variety with a compact habit and rich green foliage. Heat and drought tolerant.



## **Viette's Little Suzy • *Rudbeckia fulgida 'Viette's Little Suzy'***

12-14" x 12"      Full Sun      Zone 3

Daisy-like, golden-yellow flowers bloom from July to September. This dwarf variety has a compact habit and rough, green foliage. Heat and drought tolerant.
