

# Salvia

**Location:** Zone 3-4, sun, well-drained soil

**Shape:** Upright, mounded

**Foliage:** Green to blue-green

**Flowers:** Summer to early fall

**Notes:** Place the salvia in borders and rock gardens as they require little care. Deadhead spent flowers for longer blooming. The flowers attract butterflies.

## **Blue Hill • *Salvia nemerosa* 'Blue Hill'**

18" x 24"      Full Sun      Zone 3

Sky blue flower spikes in June and July will rebloom if deadheaded. Blue-green foliage has a mounded growth habit. Attracts butterflies and prefers well-drained soil.



## **Blue Marvel • *Salvia nemerosa* 'Blue Marvel' PP 27,018**

12-14" x 15-18"      Full Sun      Zone 4

Large, deep blue flower spikes rebloom May through August. Forms a compact mound of gray-green foliage. Prefers well-drained soil and is somewhat drought tolerant.



## **Caradonna • *Salvia nemerosa* 'Caradonna'**

24-30" x 24-30"      Full Sun      Zone 3

Violet blue flowers bloom on dark purple stems from June to July, reblooming when dead-headed. Blue-green foliage has an upright growth habit. Best in well-drained soil.



## **May Night • *Salvia nemerosa* 'Mainacht'**

18" x 24"      Full Sun      Zone 3

Spreading mound of dark green foliage that is topped with royal purple flower spikes in June and July. Will rebloom if deadheaded. Prefers well-drained soil.



## **Rose Marvel • *Salvia nemerosa* 'Rose Marvel' PP 30,118**

12" x 12"      Full Sun      Zone 4

Large, deep rose-pink flower spikes in May and June. Replaces 'Sensation Rose.' Green foliage is fragrant and grows in an upright mound. Prefers well-drained soil.
