

# Sempervivum (Hens & Chicks)

**Location:** Zone 3, sun to light shade, drought tolerant, low maintenance

**Shape:** Mat-like groundcover

**Foliage:** Bright green with burgundy tips, succulent

**Notes:** Emerald green leaves with deep red centered heads form open rosettes. In summer, older rosettes send out thick stems topped with clusters of small purple blooms. Rosettes die after flowering; younger rosettes fill in. Adds excellent texture and color to containers and rock gardens.

## **Black • *Sempervivum 'Black'***

4-6" x 6-12"                      Sun/light shade                      Zone 3

Bright green foliage with dark burgundy tips that darken to purplish-bronze in fall. Starry, white flowers on thick stalks in summer. A drought tolerant, mat-forming groundcover.



## **Ruby Heart • *Sempervivum 'Ruby Heart'***

3-4" x 8-10"                      Sun/light shade                      Zone 3

Rosettes of sharply pointed, silvery blue to blue-green leaves are flushed rosy red at the base. Purple-pink flowers are held aloft on short, leafy stalks in mid-summer. Drought tolerant.
