

# Solidago (Goldenrod)

**Location:** Zone 4, full sun, well-drained soil

**Shape:** Clump forming

**Foliage:** Lanceolate medium green leaves

**Flowers:** Late summer to early fall.

**Notes:** Commonly called goldenrod they are grown for their bright yellow or gold flowers. They are great additions to fall gardens and are very attractive to bees and butterflies. They are typically found in open areas such as meadows, prairies, and savannas. Native to North America.

One of the most compact goldenrods with light yellow flowers in July and August. Low maintenance, drought tolerant and deer resistant. Attracts pollinators.
