Solidago (Goldenrod)

Location: Zone 4, full sun, well-drained soil

Shape: Clump forming

Foliage: Lanceolate medium green leaves

Flowers: Late summer to early fall.

Notes: Commonly called goldenrod they are grown for their bright yellow or gold flowers. They are great additions to fall gardens and are very attractive to bees and butterflies. They are typically found in open areas such as meadows, prairies, and savannas. Native to North America.
