

Veronica (Speedwell)

Location: Zone 3-4, sun to part shade, moist, well-drained soil

Shape: Upright

Foliage: Medium to dark green

Flowers: Summer

Notes: Long blooming flowers grow on spikes held above low growing, dense, foliage. Deadhead to extend bloom period. Use in rock gardens and as cut flowers.

First Lady • *Veronica longifolia* 'Allady' PP 23,271

16-20" x 18" Sun/part shade Zone 4

White flower spikes emerge from bright green foliage. Compact grower with long-blooming flowers that attract butterflies and hummingbirds. Deer resistant and drought tolerant.



First Love • *Veronica longifolia* 'Alllove' PP 21,478

10-15" x 18-20" Sun/part shade Zone 4

Pinkish-red flower spikes bloom from June to August, reblooming when deadheaded. Upright, compact mound of dark green foliage. Prefers moist, well-drained soil.



Royal Candles • *Veronica* 'Royal Candles' PP 18,432

12-15" x 10-15" Full Sun Zone 3

Deep violet-blue flower spikes bloom from June through August. Disease resistant, green foliage has an upright habit. Prefers moist, well-drained soil.



Sunny Border Blue • *Veronica* 'Sunny Border Blue'

18-24" x 18" Sun/part shade Zone 3

Crinkled, deep green foliage and thick, dark blue-violet flower spikes bloom in July and August. A favorite of butterflies and hummingbirds. Drought tolerant.
