Yucca (Adam's Nedle)

Location: Zone 4, sun, well-drained soil, drought tolerant

Shape: Upright flower stalks, mounded

Foliage: Green

Flowers: Summer

Notes: Creamy-white conical inflorescences range from 4' to 6' tall, blooming during July and August, and are quite showy when in flower. Either in group plantings or solitary, use at entranceways, borders, rock gardens, island beds, or as a specimen accent.

Color Guard • Yucca filamentosa 'Color Guard'

72" x 48" Full Sun Zone 4

Large, white flowers bloom on tall stalks in July and August. Variegated yellow and green foliage is sword shaped and showy. Best in well-drained soil, drought tolerant.



Adam's Needle Yucca • Yucca filamentosa

2-3' x 3-4' Full/Partial Sun Zone 4

A slow-growing broadleaf evergreen succulent that grows blade-like leaves that form a basal rosette. Foliage clumps are 2 to 3 feet tall. Mature plants send up large flower stalks from the center of the foliage in late spring or summer, the stalks as tall as 8 feet and topped with numerous bell-shaped, creamy white flowers that attract butterflies and hummingbirds.
