

# Blueberry

## Chippewa

*Vaccinium corymbosum*

'Chippewa'

H: 3-4' W: 2'

Sun/light shade

**ZONE 3**

A self-fruitful selection developed by the University of Minnesota. It produces high yields of fruit in August that are firm and sweet. It has an upright growth habit with glossy green foliage that turns orange-red in fall.



## Duke

*Vaccinium 'Duke'*

H: 4-6' W: 4-5'

Sun/light shade

**ZONE 4**

An early-season variety that is high-yielding and hardy. The attractive fruit is medium to large, light blue, and slightly tart. Glossy dark green foliage turns orange-red in fall. Plant in evenly moist, acidic soil.



## Lowbush

*Vaccinium angustifolium*

H: 1-2' W: 1-3'

Sun/part shade

**ZONE 2**



Glossy foliage is red-green in spring, dark blue-green in summer, & maroon-purple in fall. Small, white, pink-tinged, bell-shaped flowers are followed by edible blue fruit. Plant multiple for the best fruit production. Does best in well-drained, acidic soil with a pH less than 6.



## Patriot

*Vaccinium 'Patriot'*

H: 4-6' W: 4-5'

Sun/light shade

**ZONE 4**

Profusion of pink-tinged white flowers produces an early crop of very large, firm, sweet blueberries. Dark green foliage has lovely yellow, bronze and red fall color. Excellent as a hedge or specimen.



## Polaris

*Vaccinium 'Polaris'*

H: 3-4' W: 3-4'

Sun/light shade

**ZONE 3**

Noted for its tight form, dense foliage, and larger yields of medium sized, sweet fruit in July and early August. White bell-shaped flowers cover the plant in early May and orange red foliage in the fall.
