*Clethra 'Novacleein'* PP 27,590

H: 3-4' W: 3-4'

Sun/Shade

**ZONE 4**

Twisted strands of long white flowers emit a sweet fragrance that is especially attractive to pollinators. Lush green foliage grows in a rounded, compact form. Fall color is golden brown. Does well in heavier soils.



## Ruby Spice

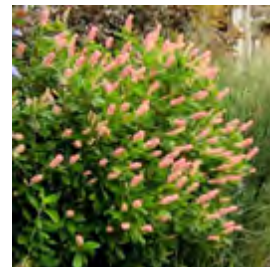
*Clethra alnifolia 'Ruby Spice'*

H: 3-5' W: 3-4'

Sun/Shade

**ZONE 4**

Bright rose-pink flowers on 4" spikes bloom for weeks in the summer on an upright, mounded form. Bluegreen leaves turn yellow in the fall. An important nectar source for butterflies and bees. Tolerates wet sites.



## Sixteen Candles

*Clethra alnifolia 'Sixteen Candles'*

H: 4' W: 2-3'

Sun/Shade

**ZONE 4**

Creamy white, candle-like spikes are 6" tall and extremely fragrant when they bloom in mid-summer. Rounded growth habit with dark green leaves that turn yellow in fall. Best in moist, acidic soil.



## Sugartina®

*Clethra alnifolia 'Crystallina'*

PP 21,561

H: 2-3' W: 2-3'

Sun/Shade

**ZONE 4**



Compact, rounded form that needs little pruning maintains its shape. Very fragrant pure white flowers attract butterflies in mid-summer. Dark glossy green foliage turns yellow in fall. Tolerates wet sites.
