Cotoneaster apiculatus

H: 2-3' W: 3-6'

Sun/part shade

ZONE 4

Dense, spreading, arching branches with small pinkish flowers in early summer, cranberry red fruit in fall through winter. Small, dark green leaves turn bronze in fall. Drought and salt tolerant, good for bank cover.



Peking (Hedge)

Cotoneaster lucidus

H: 8-10' W: 4-6'

Sun/part shade

ZONE 3

Dense, upright form is ideal for a natural hedge or screen. Reddish flowers are followed by long-lasting black fruit. Dark green leaves turn orange-red in fall. Thrives in poor soil and needs little maintenance.
