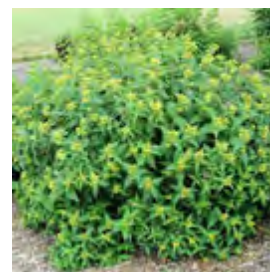
Diervilla sessilifolia 'Butterfly'

H: 3-5' W: 3-5'

Sun/part shade

ZONE 4

Upright, spreading habit with dark green leaves that turn purple in the fall. Rich yellow, upright flowers bloom for over 8 weeks. Tough, drought tolerant and generally disease resistant.



Cool Splash™

Diervilla sessilifolia 'LPDC Podaras'

H: 2.5-4' W: 2.5-4'

Sun/part shade

ZONE 3



Fast growing, densely branched with striking green leaves with bright white margins. Foliage stays bright and clean up until frost. Yellow blossoms are abundant in June & July. Versatile and low maintenance.



Dwarf Bush

H: 4' W: 3-4'

Sun/part shade

ZONE 3



Mounded, spreading habit that often suckers and forms colonies. Small yellow, trumpet shaped flowers appear in late spring. Bronze-green foliage turns red in fall and is free of disease and insect problems. Drought tolerant.



Kodiak® Orange

Diervilla lonicera 'G2X88544'

H: 3-4' W: 3-4'

Sun/part shade

ZONE 4



Forms an upright mound of glowing orange new growth and bright orange-red fall foliage. Yellow flower clusters bloom all summer. Branches stay upright and don't flop. Drought tolerant & deer resistant.



Nightglow™

Diervilla splendens 'El Madrigal'

PP 28,060

H: 2-3' W: 2-3'

Sun/light shade

ZONE 4



Dark burgundy plum foliage and bright yellow flowers contrast nicely on this compact, non-invasive, deer resistant shrub. Pollinators appreciate the long bloom time. Drought tolerant.
